Most veterans are not aware of the eldercare benefits available through VA. One particular VA program is called Veterans Pension or more commonly known as **Veterans Aid and Attendance Benefit.**

Veterans Aid and Attendance Benefit can provide up to \$2,642 per month for veterans and their spouses or surviving spouses that can be used to pay for care services.

How do I qualify for Veterans Aid and Attendance Benefits?

1. Pension is for veterans, spouses of veterans, or surviving spouses of veterans age 65 and older.
2. Must have had 90 days of continuous service, 1 day during wartime. Combat or overseas service not required.
3. The veteran/spouse must meet certain asset and income limits and need assistance with daily living on a regular basis to qualify.
