WINTER STORM - Update #1

Dear Resident,

The National Weather Service has issued a Winter Weather Advisory for our area effective until 4am Tuesday with snowfall totals expected to be 5". It is important to note that Middlesex County, just to our north is under a Winter Storm Warning and Marlboro is in an area with the possibility of higher snowfall totals. The Marlboro Office of Emergency Management (OEM) continues to keep an eye on this changeable forecast.

In preparation, please note the following:

- 1. Marlboro Police remind you that ordinance dictates that all cars, basketball hoops, etc. must be removed from the roadway when the roads are snow covered.
- 2. Department of Public Works continues to remove leaves as per the schedule. DPW Fall Leaf Collection Message
- 3. At this time, all recycling will be picked up as scheduled.

Snowfall totals are expected to vary significantly throughout the state. New Jersey has a commercial <u>travel restriction</u> in place for portions of I-78, I-80 and I-287. To facilitate road treating and plowing, an order is in place to remove a vehicle abandoned on any state or interstate roadway.

As the temperature drops and rain turns to snow, roads may be icy. Please slow down, leave extra time, and leave plenty of distance between vehicles. We will continue to monitor the weather and update as more becomes available. Thank you for your cooperation and stay safe.
