**Our Recreation Department** has programs, sports and events for all ages. We have programming for residents age 60 and over including classes, shows and trips. For the summer months, we have an active summer camp and the Marlboro Swim Club, located on Masepe Trail off Gordons Corner Road, has four pools, including an Olympic sized lap pool, dive/ slide tank, intermediate and baby pool, playgrounds, sports courts, all in a beautiful facility.
