

LEGISLATIVE MINUTES

MARLBORO TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING

October 20, 2011

The Marlboro Township Council held its regularly scheduled meeting on October 20, 2011 at 7:00 P.M. at the Marlboro Municipal Complex, 1979 Township Drive, Marlboro, New Jersey.

Council President Marder opened the meeting and announced that pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of the regularly scheduled meetings of the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro was faxed and e-mailed to the Asbury Park Press, the Star Ledger and News Transcript on January 10, 2011; faxed to the Board of Education Office; posted on the Bulletin Board of the Municipal Building, filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk and placed on the township website and Channel 77. Notice of the change in location of this meeting were faxed to the Asbury Park Press, the Star Ledger and New Transcript on October 17, 2011, posted on the township website and on Channel 77.

The Clerk called the Roll.

PRESENT: Council Vice President Cantor, Councilman LaRocca, Councilwoman Mazzola, Councilman Metzger and Council President Marder.

Also present were: Mayor Hornik, Louis Rainone, Esq., Business Administrator Jonathan Capp, Municipal Clerk Alida Manco and Deputy Municipal Clerk Deborah Usalowicz.

Council Vice President Cantor moved that the minutes of Sept. 8 & 22, 2011 be approved. This was seconded by Councilman Metzger and passed on a roll call vote of 5 - 0 in favor.

The following Resolution # 2011-374 (Authorizing Application to State of NJ Dept of Law 7 Public Safety, for DDEF Funds) was introduced by reference, offered by Councilman Metzger, seconded by Councilman LaRocca and passed on a roll call vote of 5 - 0 in favor.

RESOLUTION # 2011-374

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO TO
APPLY FOR DRUNK DRIVING ENFORCEMENT FUNDS FROM THE
NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF LAW & PUBLIC SAFETY, DIVISION
OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SAFETY

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Highway Traffic Safety (DHTS) is responsible for the administration of the Drunk Driving Enforcement Fund (DDEF) established by N.J.S.A.39:4-50.8; and

WHEREAS, under the Statute, police departments are entitled to \$95 of the \$100 surcharge resulting from a drunk driving conviction in their community. and

WHEREAS, at least 50% of the grant must be used for overtime patrols, checkpoints, or court proceedings related to drunk driving enforcement while the remainder can be used to purchase equipment, provide training and other tasks related to drunk driving enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the funds are dedicated funds and cannot be used for any other purpose; and

WHEREAS, \$3,421.34 in funds are currently available to the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Township wishes to apply for the maximum amount of funding available.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro that the Township is hereby authorized to submit an application to the New Jersey Department of Law and Public Safety, Division of Highway Traffic Safety (DHTS) and execute an agreement for funding from the Drunk Driving Enforcement Fund.

The following Resolution # 2011-375 (Authorizing Chapter 159 Budget Amendment Sustainable NJ Grant) was introduced by reference, offered by Councilman LaRocca and seconded by Councilwoman Mazzola. After discussion, the resolution was passed on a roll call vote of 5 - 0 in favor.

RESOLUTION # 2011-375

RESOLUTION REQUESTING APPROVAL OF ITEMS OF
REVENUE AND APPROPRIATION (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87)

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-87 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may approve the insertion of any special item of revenue in the budget of any County or Municipality when such item shall have been made available by law and the amount thereof was not determined at the time of the adoption of the budget; and

WHEREAS, said Director may also approve the insertion of any item of appropriation for equal amount;

Section 1

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro, in the County of Monmouth, New Jersey, hereby requests the Director of Local Government Services to approve the insertion of an revenue in the budget of the year 2011 in the sum of \$25,000.00, which has been received by the municipality for energy conservation efforts entitled the "Sustainable NJ Grant".

Section 2

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of \$25,000.00 be hereby appropriated under the caption "Sustainable NJ Grant". As the consent agenda, Res. #2011-376 (Redemption Tax Sale Certs. - Various) was introduced by reference, offered by Councilman Metzger, seconded by Councilwoman Mazzola and passed on a roll call vote of 5 - 0 in favor.

WHEREAS, the rightful owners of several properties have redeemed tax sale certificates totaling \$35,164.19 as per Schedule "A",

WHEREAS, the holders of the above-mentioned tax sale certificates are entitled to the amount of the sale plus interest and costs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Township of Marlboro that the amount of \$35,164.19 be refunded to the certificate holders as per Schedule "A",
