

LEGISLATIVE MINUTES

MARLBORO TOWNSHIP COUNCIL MEETING

October 2, 2014

The Marlboro Township Council held its regularly scheduled Council Meeting on October 2, 2014 at 7:00 P.M. at the Marlboro Municipal Complex, 1979 Township Drive, Marlboro, New Jersey.

Council President Metzger opened the meeting and announced that pursuant to the provisions of the Open Public Meetings Act, notice of the regular meetings of the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro was faxed to the Asbury Park Press, the Star Ledger and News Transcript on January 6, 2014; faxed to the Board of Education Office; posted on the Bulletin Board of the Municipal Building; filed in the office of the Municipal Clerk and placed on the township website and Channel 77.

The Clerk called the Roll.

PRESENT: Councilman LaRocca (7:10pm), Councilwoman Marder, Council Vice President Mazzola and Council President Metzger. Councilman Cantor was absent.

Also present were: Mayor Jonathan L. Hornik, Louis N. Rainone, Esq., Business Administrator Jonathan Capp, Municipal Clerk Alida Manco and Deputy Municipal Clerk Deborah Usalowicz.

Councilwoman Marder moved that the minutes of September 4, 2014 be approved. This was seconded by Council President Metzger and was passed on a roll call vote of 3 - 0 in favor with Councilwoman Mazzola abstaining (Absent: Cantor).

Councilwoman Marder moved that the minutes of September 18, 2014 be approved. This was seconded by Council President Metzger and was passed on a roll call vote of 3 - 0 in favor with Councilman La Rocca abstaining (Absent: Cantor).

Council Vice President Mazzola recused herself and left the room. Council President Metzger opened the Public Hearing on Resolution #2014-335/Ordinance #2014-23 (Authorizing Acceptance of Deed Restriction by Camelot at Marlboro for Lukas Blvd - B 132, L 18.01 as Affordability Control). As there was no one who wished to speak, the Public Hearing was closed. RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, RECOGNIZING AND HONORING THE ARMED FORCES HERITAGE HOUSE MUSEUM

WHEREAS, the mission of the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum is to preserve, present, and educate all on the rich history,

artistry, heritage, and environment of the Armed Forces located at the Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst; and

WHEREAS, in pursuit of its mission, the goal of the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum is to create and build a museum on the perimeter of the Joint Base that is accessible to the general public and will present the heritage and history of the Base from its inception in 1917 to the present day; and

WHEREAS, the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum recognizes the importance of the Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, which serves as a national model as the Country's first operational joint base and only tri-service joint base, is home to over 80 missions, represents all service branches of the United States Military, and provides a centralized location for military operations in New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, the Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst has conducted basic training, combat training, airlift, airdrop, air-refueling and aeromedical operational missions, anti-submarine warfare, crucial aircraft carrier engineering, and other vital functions which are underscored by the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum in its effort to raise awareness about the Joint Base; and

WHEREAS, the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum displays unwavering patriotism and outstanding support for America's military personnel and their families; and

WHEREAS, the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum will serve as a major tourist attraction in close proximity to Plumsted Township that will provide economic growth throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Senate and General Assembly have each adopted a Resolution recognizing the valuable service and commitment of the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum, it is accordingly fitting and proper for us to recognize the contributions and patriotism of this organization.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of Marlboro, County of Monmouth, State of New Jersey, that they do hereby honor and recognize the Armed Forces Heritage House Museum for its commitment, service and undertaking to establish a world-class museum for the Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Marlboro as part of its 2014 capital program (120-1) authorized the purchase of a DUMP TRUCK WITH SNOWPLOW, SANDER AND WETTING SYSTEM to replace existing 1994 unit (ID#9411) with over 119,000 miles for the Department of Public Works Road Division; and

WHEREAS, the submission of the apparent lowest bidder, Trius, Inc., included two exceptions which were determined to be non-material in nature in a September 23, 2014 memo submitted by the Acting Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Director of Public Works has reported that Trius, Inc. is the apparent responsive low bidder, and has recommended that the contract for ONE (1) NEW 42,000 GVWR DUMP TRUCK WITH RELATED EQUIPMENT be awarded to Trius, Inc., 458 Johnson Avenue, Bohemia, NY 11716; and

WHEREAS, the bid was comprised of a base bid, Option 1 and Option 2; and

WHEREAS, the Acting Director of Public Works has recommended that the contract be awarded to Trius, Inc. for the base bid plus Option 2 for an amount not to exceed \$174,915.00; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council have indicated their desire to accept the recommendation of the Acting Director of Public Works as set forth herein;

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AMENDMENT TO THE PURCHASE OF REPLACEMENT MUNICIPAL PARK PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT FROM MARTURANO RECREATION CO. FOR THE MARLBORO TOWNSHIP RECREATION DEPARTMENT UNDER STATE CONTRACT #81411

WHEREAS, by Resolution #2014-207, dated May 15, 2014, the Township of Marlboro authorized the purchase and installation of replacement playground equipment from Marturano Recreation Co. and Rubbercycle, LLC in the amount of \$49,950.00; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-12, a municipality may, without advertising for bids, purchase goods under any contract for such goods entered into on behalf of the State by the Division of Purchase and Property in the Department of Treasury; and

WHEREAS, in a memo dated September 25, 2014, the Director of Recreation has advised that additional curbing, safety material and labor will be needed from Marturano Recreation Co. to complete the installation in an amount which will exceed the original authorization by \$700.00; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council desires to approve the amendment to the purchase of said playground equipment.

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN AMENDMENT TO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES CONTRACT BETWEEN CME ASSOCIATES AND THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO FOR THE PREPARATION OF A WATER SYSTEM ANALYSIS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS WATER UTILITY DIVISION

WHEREAS, the Township dissolved the Marlboro Township Municipal Utilities Authority (MTMUA) in 2009; and

WHEREAS, no computerized hydraulic modeling, representing system infrastructure, operating conditions, system demand data, etc. existed at that time; and

WHEREAS, such computerized hydraulic model is required to efficiently and effectively perform evaluations of system conditions, capabilities and identify impacts to system operations by demands on the system as may be imposed by existing and future connections to the system; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works is in the process of preparing its 2015 Capital Plan; and

WHEREAS, a number of water system improvement proposals concerning the southeast section of the system are being considered in connection with State-funded improvements on the State owned parcels in the vicinity of Conover Road as well as an emergency interconnection with New Jersey American Water Company; and

WHEREAS, computerized hydraulic modeling of the water system is required in order to assess system operating conditions and identify improvements to the system necessary to maintain adequate flow and pressure of water to residents served by the system; and

WHEREAS, computerized hydraulic modeling of the water system will enable evaluation of various alternatives for improvements to the system to be considered and evaluated for cost effectiveness; and

WHEREAS, CME Associates has provided a proposal dated September 26, 2014 (the "Proposal") for the professional services required in connection with the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Marlboro and CME Associates have entered into a Professional Services Contract, awarded under a fair and open process, and seeks to amend such Contract to expand the scope of services to include the Professional Services (as defined hereinabove) for the Project at a fee not to exceed \$34,400.00 for such Professional Services, as further described and set forth in CME's Proposal, attached hereto and made a part hereof; and

WHEREAS, the value of the Professional Services Contract will exceed \$17,500.00 in the aggregate; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified that funds in the amount of \$34,400.00 are available for this purpose from Account # 06-215-10-17A-500288; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has deemed it necessary and in the best interest of the Township of Marlboro to amend its contract with CME Associates to provide the required additional Professional Services for the Project in accordance with the Proposals; and

WHEREAS, the services to be provided are considered to be "Professional Services" pursuant to the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law authorizes the awarding of a contract for "Professional Services" without public advertising for bids and bidding therefore, provided that the Resolution authorizing the contract and the contract itself be available for public inspection in the office of the Municipal Clerk and that notice of the awarding of the contract be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the municipality; and

WHEREAS, CME has previously completed and submitted a Political Contribution Disclosure Form certifying that CME Associates has not made any reportable contributions that would bar the award of a contract pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5, and that no reportable contributions that would violate the law will be made during the term of the contract.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of Marlboro that a Professional Services Contract between CME Associates and the Township of Marlboro, to expand the scope of services to include THE PREPARATION OF A WATER SYSTEM ANALYSIS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS WATER UTILITY DIVISION by way of its Township Engineers ("Professional Services"), at a fee not to exceed \$34,400.00 for such Professional Services, as further described and set forth in CME's Proposal dated September 26, 2014 ("Proposal"), be and is hereby authorized; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute, and the Clerk to witness, in a form legally acceptable to the Township Attorney, the Professional Services Contract described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Professional Services Contract is awarded without competitive bidding pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i) and shall provide for compensation in an amount not to exceed \$34,400.00 for such additional Professional Services for the Project as described in the Proposal; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a copy of the Professional Services Contract and this Resolution shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Municipal Clerk; and

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING APPLICATION TO THE
COUNTY OF MONMOUTH FOR OPEN SPACE TRUST FUNDS

WHEREAS, the Monmouth County Board of Chosen Freeholders has approved an Open Space Trust Fund and established a Municipal Open Space Program to provide Program Grant funds in connection with municipal acquisition of lands for County park, recreation, conservation and farmland preservation purposes, as well as for County recreation and conservation development and maintenance purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the Township of Marlboro desires to obtain County Open Space Trust Funds in the amount of \$145,000.00 to construct tennis courts on the property known as the Nolan Road Park, located at Lloyd and Nolan Roads within the Township of Marlboro (Block 127, Lot 11); and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project including all matching funds is \$290,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Township of Marlboro is the owner of and controls the project site.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF MARLBORO THAT:

1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to (a) make an application to the County of Monmouth for Open Space Trust Funds, (b) provide additional application information and furnish such documents as may be required for the Municipal Open Space Grants Program and (c) act as the municipal contact person and correspondent of the above named municipality; and
2. The Township of Marlboro is committed to this project and will provide the balance of funding necessary to complete the project in the form of non-county matching funds as required in the Policy and Procedures Manual for the Program; and
3. If the County of Monmouth determines that the application is complete and in conformance with the Monmouth County Municipal Open Space Program and the Policy and Procedures Manual for the Municipal Grants Program adopted thereto, the municipality is willing to use the approved Open Space Trust Funds in accordance with such policies and procedures, and applicable federal, state, and local government rules, regulations and statutes thereto; and
4. Mayor Jonathan Hornik is hereby authorized to sign and execute any required documents, agreements, and amendments thereto with the County of Monmouth for the approved Open Space Trust Funds; and
5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
