- DPW announces that spring brush pickup has been completed. **There should be no brush curbside at this time.** Leaf pickup for Zones 3, 5, 6 & 7 will begin on July 6 and must be curbside no later than 7am on the first day of the scheduled pickup week. Throughout the year, both leaves and brush may be brought to the recycling yard at no charge or you may contact a private contractor for removal.  - Leaves commingled with brush, grass, rocks, stumps, construction debris, fence posts, etc. trash or recyclables will not be collected. Leaves may not be placed curbside earlier than one week prior to the first scheduled collection day. In the interest of public safety, homeowners and their landscapers are reminded not to blow or place leaves into the street but placed adjacent to the curb in piles or in bio-degradable paper bags.
- Finally, we remind you that pet licenses are required to be renewed each year in January. If you have not paid your license for 2015, please see the Notice and Application [HERE](#). Beginning July

1 you will be subject to a \$50 fine. Licensing your pet helps to return a lost pet home, ensures proper vaccination and is State Law. Thank you for your cooperation.
