

Dear Resident:

Please note that the Department of Public Works (DPW) continues spring BRUSH ONLY pick up according to the schedule published in the recycling calendar mailed to your home, available on the Township website or here: http://www.marlboro-nj.gov/Marlboro_recycling_Calendar_2015.pdf.

The zone by zone brush pickup dates for May are:

May 4	Zones 3 & 5
May 11	Zones 6 & 7
May 18	Zones 1 & 8
May 25	Zones 2 & 4

The zone by zone brush pickup dates for June are:

June 1	Zones 3, 5, 6,& 7
June 8	Zones 1,2,4 & 8
June 15	Zones 3,5,6 & 7
June 22	Zones 1,2,4 & 8

Please note that there is no leaf pick up until July and there should be no leaves curbside at this time. Brush and leaves may NOT be commingled.

Brush is to be placed curbside by 7:00am on the first day of the scheduled pickup week free of leaves or other debris but not more than one week prior Weather permitting, it generally takes approximately one week to complete each zone. Once a street has been completed, the Department of Public Works will not return to that street. For the safety of pedestrians and motorists, brush should be placed at the curb no earlier than one week prior to the first scheduled collection date.

All brush is to be cut to a maximum length of six (6) feet and a maximum diameter of four (4) inches and should not exceed fifty (50) pounds in weight. Branches less than one inch in diameter shall be tied in neat bundles no more than four (4) feet in length and two (2) feet across.

Brush commingled with leaves, grass, rocks, stumps, construction debris, fence posts, etc., trash or recyclables will not be collected. Landscapers or residents placing debris for collection in an unauthorized manner shall be required to remove the waste from the public right of way.

The annual **Bulk Trash/Spring cleanup** has been completed as per the schedule printed in your recycling calendar. We remind you that electronics (TVs, computers, etc.) are not picked up curbside as per state law, but may be brought to the recycling center free of charge and without a permit. In addition, throughout the year, bulk items may be brought to the Township Recycling Yard with a free of charge bulk permit. Permits are available at the Recycling office Monday to Friday 7am to 7pm. Proof of residency is required. The Recycling Center is open Monday and Wednesday from 8am to 1:30pm and Saturdays from 8am to 4pm.
