**LEAF ONLY PICKUP TO BEGIN BY ZONE**

October, 2017

Dear resident,

The Department of Public Works (DPW) will begin LEAF ONLY pickup as per the schedule published in the Recycling Calendar mailed to your home, available on-line or [HERE](#).

Zones 3 & 5	October 23	November 27
Zones 2 & 4	October 30	December 4
Zones 1 & 8	November 6	December 11
Zones 6 & 7	November 13	December 18

The zone by zone **LEAF ONLY** pickup dates for October through December are:

\*\*\*We remind you that the Marlboro Office of Emergency Management (OEM) can delay or cancel any curbside pickup due to weather conditions. **It is therefore crucial that lawn debris is not placed curbside more than one week prior to your scheduled pickup date.** Please check Township email and the website for updates regarding schedule changes and adjustments. Thank you for your cooperation.

Please note these dates are for **LEAF ONLY** pickup. Brush pickup has been completed for all zones for the remainder of 2017. **NO brush may be curbside and leaves and brush may not be comingled.**

Leaves are to be placed either adjacent to the curb in piles or in biodegradable paper bags by 7:00 am on the first day of the scheduled pickup week, free of branches or other debris. For the safety of pedestrians and motorists, leaves should be placed at the curb no earlier than one week prior to the first scheduled collection date. Weather permitting, it generally takes approximately one week to complete each set of zones. Once a street has been completed, the Department of Public Works will not return to that street.

We also remind you that FIRE SAFETY strongly suggests that vehicles are not parked on or within 10 feet of lawn debris. Parking cars on piles of leaves is a fire hazard and blocking the leaves also prevents access to the material for collection.

Leaves comingled with brush, grass, rocks, stumps, construction debris, fence posts, etc., trash or recyclables will not be collected. Landscapers or residents placing debris for collection in an unauthorized manner shall be required to remove the waste from the public right of way.
