MARLBORO TOWNSHIP LAUNCHES OFFICAL FACEBOOK PAGE AND TWITTER FEED

MARLBORO TOWNSHIP, NEW JERSEY (July 18, 2013) – As a part of an ongoing initiative to provide information to Township residents, Marlboro Township introduced a Facebook Page and Twitter feed on July 10, 2013. Social media will be used to enhance the information currently found on the Township’s website while allowing a more rapid distribution of programs and events, road projects that may temporarily affect traffic conditions as well as information to prepare for weather emergencies.

"Especially in the aftermath of Hurricane Sandy, we cannot stress enough the importance of having multiple lines of communication with the Township," said Mayor Jonathan Hornik, who continued, "Adding Facebook and Twitter to the existing town email blasts and reverse 911 calls will allow us to be in communication with our residents in both good times and during disruptions to some lines of communication."
