GENERAL INFORMATION

- Marlboro's recreation programs are open to all Marlboro Township residents. Some programs are available to non-residents.
- Children must be currently enrolled in an accredited kindergarten program or higher grade in September 2015 to be eligible to participate, unless other age minimum is stated.
- Each participant must be fully registered (including payment of registration fee) to be eligible to participate in any program.
- The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel any course which is not fully registered and to limit registration for designated courses. Registration fees are not refundable except for the above situations.
- Full and partial scholarships are available for residents for whom fee payments would impose a financial hardship. Application for such a scholarship should be made with the Public Assistance Officer at 732-617-0100.
- The Recreation Department reserves the right to suspend any individual enrolled in a program for disciplinary reasons. Neither partial nor full refund will be made.
- Further questions may be directed to the Recreation Office at 732-617-0100 between 8:30am and 4:00pm Monday through Friday.
- We accept credit cards (Visa/MC), checks or money orders. Checks and money orders are made payable to Marlboro Recreation. Cash for the exact amount is accepted at the Recreation/Swim Office only.

DO NOT MAIL CASH.

- Class Refund Policy: Refund requests must be made to the Recreation Office no less than five (5) business days prior to the start of the program.
- **Returned Check Fee - \$20.00 / Charge for Refunds - \$5.00 per Program**
- **REGISTRATION DEADLINE: one week prior to first class!**
- **No refunds after program begins.**
