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GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Marlboro’s recreation programs are open to Marlboro Township residents only.
2. Children must be currently enrolled in an accredited kindergarten program or higher grade in September 2009 to be eligible to participate, unless other age minimum is stated.
3. Each participant must be fully registered (including payment of registration fee) to be eligible to participate in any program.
4. The Recreation Commission reserves the right to cancel any course which is not fully registered and to limit registration for designated courses. Registration fees are not refundable, except for the above situations. **No refund after** program begins.
5. Full and partial scholarships are available for residents for whom fee payments would impose a financial hardship. Application for such a scholarship should be made with the Public Assistance Officer at 617-0100.
6. **INCLEMENT WEATHER:** If schools are closed during the day, no recreation programs will be held regardless of weather conditions that evening. Any cancelled sessions may be **rescheduled at the discretion of the Recreation Department.**
7. The Recreation Commission reserves the right to suspend any individual enrolled in a program for disciplinary reasons. Neither partial nor full refund will be made.
8. Further questions may be directed to the Recreation Office, 617-0100 between 8:30am and 4 pm Monday through Friday.
9. Only checks or money orders made payable to Marlboro Recreation will be accepted. **DO NOT SEND CASH.**
10. Class Refund policy: Refund requests must be made to the Recreation office no less than five (5) business days prior to the start of the program
11. Returned Check **Fee - \$35.00** / Charge for Refunds - **\$5.00 per Program**
12. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE: One week prior to first class!**




