Proposed Tree Park

The State continues restoring the former Marlboro Psychiatric property. The property will be preserved as a park. Plans will be revisited at the time the state transfers' ownership to Marlboro Township which is estimated near year end of 2014.

Open items from the December meeting

- **Five Year Forestry Plan** –. The committee is on track for the first half of the year to meet our goals. The 2013 Annual Accomplishment Report was completed, signed, and submitted to the state of NJ for approval. Receipt of the application was completed.
- **Tree City USA** – The Re-Certification application was completed, signed, and submitted to the National Arbor Day foundation for approval.
- **Arbor Day 2014** – The committee decided to keep the Arbor Day celebration confined to the grounds around Town Hall. The Breakfast will be held at Town Hall followed by speeches before we have the Mayor read an Arbor Day Proclamation and a Ceremonial Tree Planting to commemorate Arbor Day. Arbor Day will take place on April 26, 2014 at 9:00am. Girl Scout Troop 1795 will participate.
- **Community Garden** – The Township did not receive the CSIP Grant for our Community Garden. However, the committee is moving forward with this project. We continued discussing the layout, parking, fencing, and trees. Security of the property was reviewed.
- **Beautification and The Memorial Day Parade** – The committee will participate and support both events in 2014 taking place on May 17th and May 18th.

New Business

- The website will be updated with new members
- The committee will become involved in the upkeep of the Veterans Memorial Garden located in front of Town Hall.
- The State offers courses for CE Credits.
