Swim Camp

The Marlboro Swim Club Day Camp is a 7-week program that runs Monday through Friday from 11:00 am to 4:00pm. Campers must be between the ages of 4 and 9 years old. Daily activities include recreational pool time, playground activities, sports, arts and crafts, music and dance, theme days, and more! There are new special events coming to camp this summer that include slides, magicians, petting zoos, and other guests. Parents will receive a calendar of events prior to the season and will receive reminders during the season so that no campers miss out on the fun.

Our camps are held solely on the ground of the swim club and are staffed with adult supervisors, counselors, and an on-site EMT. Each grade level has a supervisor and counselor to camper ratio depends on the group size and age. For our younger campers our minimum ratio is 6:1. For our older campers our minimum ratio is 8:1.

NEW! This year we will be offering a Before Camp program from 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM. This program will include a variety of activities to keep campers engaged and active. Before care will be run by the Assistant Day Camp Director and select counselors. This program will be first come first serve and will be capped at a maximum capacity for safety purposes. This program will follow our 7-week day camp schedule.

Camp Dates

June 27th All Marlboro Swim Club Camps will begin.

July 4th No camp will be held on July 4th.

August 1st Color War and Sports Camp Olympics will start (Shh... it's a secret!)

August 9th Our annual Camp Show. Times will be announced closer to the event.

Sports Camp

For children ages 8-12 we offer a camp with a complete emphasis on sports. This camp is held within the swim club grounds but also utilizes the facilities adjacent to the club. We have access to basketball courts, tennis courts, wall ball courts, soccer fields, and baseball fields.

During this 7-week program campers will learn and develop a variety of motor skills that can help improve their game. Our supervisors and counselors create schedules that incorporate time to work on individual skills, team building, and game knowledge. Once campers acquire an understanding of these components they will move on to competitive games. Throughout the camp season there will be various individual and team awards given to our campers who are improving, working hard, and showing good sportsmanship!

Last summer, the Olympic Events were added to our sports camp program. For one week the sports camp will compete in teams to see who will be the Olympic Champions. In their teams they will show spirit by creating team banners and competing in various field events and competitions.

Campers will follow schedules throughout the day and will have specific times set for lunch, recreational games, and swimming. These campers will also be scheduled to attend the events that come to camp.

Special Needs

Is your child classified by the Marlboro Township Board of Education? If so please contact us at 732-617-9600 to discuss the needs of your child prior to registration.

Please note the ratio of staff members to campers. If your child requires more supervision than we can provide it may not be in your child's best interest to apply for a program that does not suit his or her needs. If more supervision is needed we request that you provide information concerning your child in writing to the Recreation Department prior to enrollment.

Failure to provide this information prior to enrollment may result in your child not being admitted to the program. This will be due to the fact that the Recreation Department has not been provided with an adequate opportunity to assess whether or not it can make reasonable accommodations for the specific needs of your child.



Activities Camp

For ages 8-12, we offer a program that engages our campers in arts and crafts, jewelry making, scrapbooking, karaoke, “salon days”, music and dance.

These campers will also have the opportunity to swim, play sports, create scavenger hunts, and participate in other camp events. Our activities camp will play an important role in our End of Camp Show and will participate in camp Color War.



General information about camp...

Registration

Children must be 4 years of age prior to the first day of camp (June 27th) in order to be eligible for this summer. No exceptions will be made.

Payment

Please make your check payable to the Marlboro Swim Club. The \$100 non-refundable deposit is due when you register. The remaining balance must be received no later than May 6th or your child's spot will be forfeited.

Refund Policy

There will be no camp refunds after May 6th for any reason including illness.

If a child is asked by the swim club management to leave camp during the first three weeks only 25% of the fee shall be refunded.

ID Cards

For security reasons an ID card is required any time you enter the facility. Therefore any camper or any adult entering for the day camp program must present their ID at the front gate to gain access into the facility. If you do not have an ID card you may be denied entrance into the swim club.

Requirements for drop off and pick up...

For the safety of each camper and for the safety of our swim club members, parents and guardians of campers will not be permitted to enter the circle to drop off or pick up a camper. Emergency vehicles need to be able to access the circle if necessary. You **MUST** park in the parking lot and walk into the facility. Failure to follow this policy may result in the camper being asked to leave the camp and forfeiture of all fees paid.

Drop off Time: Counselors arrive for work between 10:45 to 10:50 AM. Please do not drop off your child before that time unless they are in our before camp program.

If you secure a spot in our Before Camp program the drop off time is 9:00 AM.

Pick up Time: Day camp ends promptly at 4:00 PM. All campers must be picked up by this time. The Swim Club staff is unavailable to watch campers if parents pick up their children late. For any parents who are frequently late, the swim club may dismiss your child from the day camp.

2016 Summer Camp Fees & Information

Before Camp Program

Ages 4 to 12 years old. Starts June 27th and ends on August 12th. No camp on July 4th. Camp hours are 9:00 AM to 11:00 AM. Total Additional Cost: \$190. Non-residents pay an additional \$25. Space is limited.

Swim Club Camp

Ages 4 to 9 years old. Starts June 27th and ends on August 12th. No camp on July 4th. Camp hours are 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Total Cost: \$700 for early registration. After April 16th the rate raises to \$730.

Sports Camp

Ages 8 to 12 years old. Starts June 27th and ends on August 12th. No camp on July 4th. Camp hours are 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Total Cost: \$725 for early registration. After April 16th the rate raises to \$755.

Activities Camp

Ages 8-12 years old. Starts June 27th and ends on August 12th. No camp on July 4th. Camp hours are 11:00 AM to 4:00 PM. Total Cost: \$725 for early registration. After April 16th the rate raises to \$755.

All non-residents will pay an additional \$100 fee for any of the camp programs.

Health and Safety Concerns

The Marlboro Swim Club Day Camp is a nut free camp. DO NOT send your child to camp with nuts or foods containing nut ingredients. This creates a dangerous situation to children who have allergic reactions to nut products including peanut butter and Nutella.

KEEP IN MIND... The Swim Club Facility is not a nut free facility therefore parents of children with nut allergies should remind their child to be cautious of their environment.

Parent Notifications

For any information regarding closures of camp, parents will be notified via *Community Pass*.

If you are not receiving Community Pass notifications please check your account and make sure your correct email has been answered. Please contact the Day Camp Director with any issues.

Parents will receive Community Pass messages when there are delayed openings or camp closings.

Delayed Openings

If morning weather conditions are rainy but indications exist that it may clear after mid-morning we will have a delayed opening and begin camp at 1pm. If the rain does not clear camp will not be held. You will be notified via Community Pass or email.

Camp Closing

To ensure the safety of your child, if a steady rain or thunderstorm begins when camp is in session we will take the campers inside our pavilion or bathhouses. Depending on the severity of the rain and overall weather conditions camp may be closed for the day. If camp is closed for the day parents are responsible for picking up their child from the facility.

Please be aware of the weather and in the area should there be inclement weather.
