Unacceptable items: hypodermic needles, medical waste, mercury thermometers, illegal drugs or paraphernalia.

The Marlboro Township Police Department and the Marlboro Alliance for the Prevention of Substance Abuse are holding this event to allow residents to anonymously turn in medications, raise awareness about the dangers of prescription drug abuse, and dispose of unwanted drugs in the proper manner.

All residents are urged to take advantage of this program.

Please, remember to never flush left over medicine down the toilet or sink. This causes water pollution, impacts drinking water and has adverse effects on septic systems, fish and other aquatic wildlife.
