Dear Resident,

In response to recent car burglaries, Marlboro Police remind residents to lock their car doors and take their key fobs.

Sunday night Marlboro, along with surrounding towns, experienced car burglaries. Neighboring towns also had cars stolen from the driveways. In ALL cases, the cars were left unlocked. In several cases, cars in the garage were also burglarized as the unlocked cars in the driveway allowed thieves access to the garage door opener. Marlboro Police Officers were on patrol when they noted that cars had been burglarized. Marlboro Police contacted the homeowners while Officers on patrol checked the area for suspects.

Organized groups of thieves come to Marlboro from cities north of us, stealing vehicles or the contents primarily between the hours of 2am and 6 am. The Marlboro of Division of Police, in collaboration with the FBI and State Police, has arrested several groups but more quickly take their place.

We live in a safe community and were recently named the 34th safest city in America, but no place is immune to this type of crime. We ask residents to be our partner in keeping our community safe.

Please review the letters linked below sent via email and posted on social media asking residents to lock their cars, take the key fobs, and not to leave valuables visible. A few simple steps will help deter thieves.
