

ROAD CONSTRUCTION NOTICE – Week of September 9, 2019

**** The Department of Public Works (DPW) **EMERGENCY STORM DEBRIS REMOVAL (BRUSH ONLY)** is COMPLETE. No further lawn debris may be curbside until the regularly scheduled collection to begin late October by zone as per the recycling calendar [HERE](#).

STATE/COUNTY ROAD REPAIRS

ROUTE 520 AND TENNENT ROAD INTERSECTION – The installation of the ADA required curb ramps is complete. State contractors will return to complete striping and signage in advance of the left-turn signal becoming operational. Please see prior Road Construction Notice [HERE](#) for more.

SUBJECT TO ROAD CLOSURES – POLICE PRESENT

Pleasant Valley Road – Construction will begin Wednesday with the installation of mountable concrete curb between Conover Road and Mockingbird Lane. This project is a part of a FEMA Grant awarded August 13, 2019. The work is expected to take approximately 4 months to complete.

ROADS TO REMAIN OPEN – CONSTRUCTION ADVISORY – POLICE PRESENT

The roads will remain open and accessible during construction, although motorists are advised to use caution through the work zone.

Spring Valley Road – As reported in last week's update, the crews milled the roadway last week beginning at Tennent Road and working westward towards Texas. Paving operations have commenced, again beginning at Tennent and working their way towards Texas Road. Road repair should be completed this week.

Floyd Wycoff Road – Concrete repair and inlet reconstruction.

Bruce Road - Concrete repair and inlet reconstruction.

Ruby Drive – Concrete repair and underdrain installation.

Clubhouse Lane - DPW Milling and Paving continues.

WMUA Sewer Project – The nighttime construction has concluded and they have returned to daytime construction. No road closures are expected. If possible, we suggest that you avoid the area. Final paving on Brandon Road will be scheduled at a later date.

ROAD CONSTRUCTION PREVIEW (MAIN THOROUGHFARES)

Union Hill Road –The roadway was paved in the vicinity of the commuter lot as well as repairs within the lot completed. Additional paving in the area will be scheduled at night during the coming weeks.

Peasley Drive –HUD grant received in the amount of \$120,370 for the resurfacing of Peasley Drive.

Wooleytown Road (concrete and drainage work completed in April) will be milled and paved this fall. The contractors will then continue onto **Harbor Road** at the intersection of Rt.79. **Amboy Road** (between Tennent and Shalom Torah) and **Texas Road** (at the Amboy intersection) will be re-surfaced immediately following.
